

RV Park Rules of the Road

- **PLEASE NOTE THAT RV SITE RENTAL IS PAID IN ADVANCE AND DUE IMMEDIATELY UPON OCCUPANCY.** You can pay directly to Don Rainey, Francene DePrez or Melissa Moit, or pay in the honor box located on the red house overlooking the river between RV sites 3 and 5.
- Please follow all requests from our employees. Diamond Don Motorsports, Inc., doing business as Diamond Don RV Park, reserves the right to refuse services to anyone. Please follow all posted signs.
- **DO NOT BLOCK RV SITES. VEHICLES BLOCKING ACCESS TO RV SITES OR PARKING IN "NO PARKING" ZONES WILL BE TOWED AT OWNERS EXPENSE.** When tent camping, please do not block any designated roadways or RV sites.
- Lock up your stuff. Diamond Don Motorsports, Inc. is not liable or responsible for accidents, illness, damage, fire or theft to any person(s) or property, or damage to RV's due to electrical unit surges or malfunction. Your use of RV site electrical and water is at your own risk.
- **We do not allow leisure riding of motorcycles, golf carts or 4-wheelers on the property, except for developed roads in the RV Park and on Levee Road. You must have a valid driver's license to drive golf carts, side x sides, motorcycles or 4-wheelers. Violation of this rule will subject you to ejection from the park. No vehicle is permitted to exceed seating allotment. No reckless driving.**
- Riding on trails around the park is prohibited. If you are caught riding on the trails, you **WILL** be ejected from the park. You may drive on the developed road between the RV Park and the Historic Jefferson Railway depot, known as Levee Road.
- Leave a clean campsite. Properly dispose of oil, gas and trash.
- Do not go near our railroad track. Any person caught tampering or vandalizing the track will be immediately ejected from the property. Tampering with our track creates a dangerous situation as it could cause our train to de-rail!!
- NOISE CURFEW 11:00 pm (Music, Loud Talking, Engines, etc.) This does not apply to camping generators unless a generator has excessive noise. Generators must have mufflers and function within reasonable sound levels. We do not allow barking dogs on the property. If your dog barks, leave them home.
- **NOTE: If you damage any water or electric unit, you will immediately be charged a \$250 damage fee. WATCH WHERE YOU PARK, ESPECIALLY WHEN BACKING UP!**
- Entry into the RV Park authorizes us to use any photography of you AND your family for promotional purposes.

Your entry to the RV Park is a revocable license. The entire RV Park and adjacent train property is a restricted zone and private property subject to all posted signs. In consideration for entry to this property, you voluntarily assume all risks of injury, illness, loss or damage to person or property whether occurring prior to, during, or after visit to the RV Park. **Entry into this RV Park requires you to control your children and pets at all times.** We are not responsible for injury or illness caused by other people's pets or children. You agree that the management of the RV Park and its owners and employees are expressly released of any claims arising from all causes, whether covered by these rules or not. Management reserves the right, without the refund of any portion of the RV Park fee, to refuse service or reject any person, with or without cause. No refunds and no rain checks after purchase. **THIS IS NOT AN OFF-ROAD PARK. Off-road vehicles may use the developed roads around the RV Park and the Levee Road to the depot, using a very low speed (7.5 mph). However, all other off-road activities are strictly prohibited.**
